How to reach Brno

Travel to Brno is easy by plane, train or bus.

By train and bus: there are connections to Brno main station from and to most European cities.

Main lines: Budapest - Bratislava - Brno - Praha - Berlin, Warsaw – Olomouc - Brno - Wien

Trains departing from the Main Station in Brno (Hlavní nádraží) and regular buses leave from Zvonařka bus station and from the Grand Hotel station and connect Brno with numerous cities across Europe.

By plane: Closest airports (ranged by distance): Brno or Prague (Czech Republic), Vienna (Austria), Bratislava (Slovakia).

- Brno Airport (BRQ) – only limited connections - see <http://www.brno-airport.cz/en/>
- From Vienna Airport and Prague Airport there are bus and train connections running to Brno. Check buses and trains of Student Agency on <http://www.studentagency.eu/>, Flix bus on <https://www.flixbus.com> or Gepard Express on <https://www.gepard.com/?lang=en>. From Vienna Airport: There are several direct bus connections from the airport per day operated by Student agency (<http://www.studentagency.eu/>), the bus ride takes about 2,5 hours; for train timetables see <https://www.oebb.at/en/fahrplan>
- From Prague Airport: For timetables of trains and buses see <http://jizdnirady.idnes.cz/vlakyautobusy/spojeni/>. Connections run every hour, however it takes nearly 4 hours to get to Brno and includes changing in Prague at the Central bus station (see <http://www.studentagency.eu/>).
